 - ❖ Presentation of how to add/revise courses in e-Lumen Mike Graves would like to review with faculty members how to add and revise courses in e-Lumen at the next Academic Senate meeting on 3/16. After this brief "training," faculty members will be able use e-Lumen to update their curriculum.
 - Senate Exec will consider an evaluation of School Dude / Room Scheduling Mike indicated it would be helpful if there was a way to prioritize courses that require certain rooms / facilities (i.e., computer labs). Chris said he would discuss this issue in his upcoming meeting with Dr. Schoonmaker.
 - Senate Exec will consider an evaluation of the compressed calendar and its time blocks Chris believes this is the institution's responsibility and that the college should create an instrument / survey that assesses the effectiveness of the compressed calendar. Mike would like a "college hour" added to the calendar. Chris said he would also discuss the college hour proposal with Dr. Schoonmaker.
