# **Academic Senate Executive Meeting Minutes**

May 16, 2018 (Convened at 8:00am) in DLC Rm #4

# A. Opportunity for Public Comment

### C. Discussion Items

- ❖ <u>SLO Manual</u> The new SLO Manual was sent out to all faculty members before the Academic Senate meeting this Friday (5/18). So far, Chris has not heard any feedback about it from faculty.
- ❖ <u>Shared Governance Model</u> Classified staff have formed their own Senate. ASM is still in the process of forming their own Senate. They will probably establish their bylaws by this summer. Chris has been assured by the President that the VPs will not get double representation on committees once their Senate is established.
- ❖ Budget Shortfall A budget shortfall of about \$300,000 is estimated for next year. Chris examined the budget numbers from 2016 2017 and 2017 2018. Although faculty spending remained about the same for these fiscal years, ASM spending increased about 25%. It appears that ASM spent \$450,000 more this last fiscal year compared to the fiscal year of 2016 2017. Classified staff budget went up about \$70,000 this past fiscal year compared to the previous fiscal year.
- ❖ Community College Apportionment Funding Formula The Governor's initial funding formula has been modified. Currently, the proposed funding formula is 60/20/20. Thus, 60 percent of funding will be based on FTEs, 20 percent on underrepresented/financially needy students, and 20 percent on success rates (degree, transfer, etc.). There will be a two-year holding pattern to give colleges time to adjust before new funding formula is implemented.
