- ❖ <u>Filling out office hours / Outlook</u> Administrators need to remind faculty members that they cannot hold online office hours for a non-online course.
- ❖ <u>Midterm report update</u> Dr. Perlas would like a couple of volunteers to serve on an accreditation committee. These faculty members would mainly serve as a resource to the VP.
