That was not our intent with the COVID Vaccinated T-Shirts. In response, we are ordering T-Shirts without the 'COVID Vaccinated' statement on the back.  - 2. **Prorated Pay:** We had some discussion regarding prorated pay in last Friday's Town Hall and will continue discussions with the FA as this is a Union negotiated item. I want to clarify that indicating one's willingness to teach for prorated pay is documented on faculty contracts and is currently included in the Faculty CBA.
 - 3. Outdoor Recreation Activities: It was suggested that we look into more outdoor recreational centered classes (great recommendation!). Since this falls in the Faculty Senate's 10+1, I'll be sure to mention it to Ron so he can discuss with Senate.
 - 4. COS Connect: It was mentioned that a lot of the COS Connect messages go to the general COS Campus News subscription instead of the student or employee specific subscriptions. Many COS Connect users are choosing the 'all' subscriptions option. Dawnie has been thinking about how to better streamline communications.
