## • Suggestion Box (x2):

-Transfer of duties when people are quarantining/working remote: Understanding that in certain circumstances, when a person is working remote, some duties may fall on those who are working on-campus. I encourage you to speak to your Supervisor in these instances to develop an amenable plan moving forward.

- -Consider virtual Fridays for those who are able/prefer to work from home: As in a previous all-College email, individuals interested in working remotely, please submit any hybrid work proposals you may have to your immediate supervisor for consideration.
- **COVID Status:** To help keep the campus better informed of our COVID cases, this will be a standing item in my weekly emails. As of today, Sept. 15th at 8:45am, the College has 5 positives. We had three students added last week (2 on Friday and 1 on Saturday) and 2 students yesterday. The reported cases from the week of Sept. 6th have completed their quarantine and have dropped off the list. Contact tracing is being performed for all positives and those who have tested positive as well as those who have been exposed are abiding by the <u>CDPH Guidance on Isolation and Quarantine</u>. This guidance can also be found on our <u>September 2021 COVID Prevention Plan</u> which, when finalized, will be posted on our COVID-19 webpage. Since the COVID positive cases have been isolated to specific groups and have not resulted in campus-wide exposure, the campus, at this time is not in jeopardy of closure. Keep in mind this can change at a moment's notice, so it is especially important to abide by the mask guidelines and be diligent when around others.
