Some COS Connect messages need to be sent out immediately or, in a timely manner and therefore forming a committee to review is not feasible. - Leave forms to be available as an MS form and add 'COVID' leave: I have this on this week's Exec agenda. In thinking about this, I am not sure if an MS Form will work as, MS forms are typically a one-way process (an individual completes the form and it goes to the creator of the form and not directly to the supervisor for approval). In regards to adding 'COVID Leave', we currently have a separate form for, I believe, auditing purposes but, we will discuss and I will provide a more definitive update next week.

- **Keynote Speaker Presentation:** In case you missed it or, would like a resource, Donald Proby's presentation is attached. Thank you to everyone who attended. His presentation is a good reminder to breathe, connect and communicate.
- Black History Month: February is Black History month and, as such, we will be featuring an influential Black individual each week. This week, we are featuring Booker T.
   Washington: Booker Taliaferro Washington was born on April 5, 1856 in a hut in Franklin County, Virginia. His mother was a cook for the plantation's owner. Washington was only allowed to go to school after working from 4-9 AM each morning in a local salt works before class. It was at a second job in a local coalmine where he first heard two fellow workers discuss the Hampton Institute, a school for formerly enslaved people in southeastern Virginia founded in 1868 by Brigadier General Samuel Chapman. In 1872, Washington walked the 500 miles to Hampton, where he was an excellent student and received high grades. He went on to study at Wayland Seminary in Washington, D.C., but had so impressed Chapman that he was invited to return to Hampton as a teacher in 1879. Booker T. Washington became the first African American to be invited to the

White House in 1901, when President Theodore Roosevelt invited him to dine with him. Roosevelt saw Washington as a brilliant advisor on racial matters. (*Source: History.com*). My favorite Booker T. Washington quote: 'Success is to be measured not so much by the position that one has reached in life as by the obstacles which he has overcome.' - Booker T. Washington
