

For more than 40 years, College of the Siskiyous has provided local residents with job training and retraining and academic preparation for 4-year colleges, while also ensuring that local nurses and firefighters receive quality training to serve our county. Statistics show that at least one member of over 70% of local families have taken classes at COS or have enrolled in distance learning programs that serve the entire county.

Measure A will ensure that currently outdated and undersized classrooms and facilities can be improved and expanded for future students of all ages.

- Measure A will fund a Rural Health Sciences Institute to train even more nurses and health professionals every year in the latest medical techniques. Most of these nurses will stay here in Siskiyou County and work at local hospitals.
- Measure A will help build a Fire Science classroom facility to train future firefighters on the latest techniques and equipment.
- Measure A includes strict accountability provisions, independent audits and citizen oversight of all spending to ensure that every dollar raised by Measure A will be spent efficiently and only on the identified projects.
- Measure A funds will qualify COS for state matching funds for upgrades and repairs that will otherwise be lost to other colleges. By law, no funds raised by Measure A can be taken by the state or spent on administrative salaries.
