Measure A Money Stays Local – Not One Dime Can be Taken by the State


All funds raised by Measure A cannot be taken by the state. Every dime stays in Siskiyou County and must be spent on construction at College of the Siskiyou.

Measure A funds will qualify COS for state matching funds for upgrades and repairs that will otherwise be lost to other colleges. And, Measure A is expected to generate \$31 million in construction spending that will boost the local economy.

Community Oversight and Audits
Will Ensure That Not One Dime From
Measure A is Misspent or Wasted

Measure A includes strict accountability provisions, such as mandated independent annual audits and a citizens oversight committee to review all spending and ensure that every dime raised by Measure A will be spent efficiently and only on the identified projects.

Measure A is Only for COS Construction Projects – Not One Dime for Administration



Every dime raised by Measure A will be spent on needed facility projects- not one dime will be spent on administrative salaries. The money raised by Measure A is needed to:

- Build a new Rural Health Sciences Training Institute
- Build a Fire Science classroom facility to train future firefighters on the latest techniques and equipment
- Renovate the Life Sciences Building
- Complete the "distance learning network" to include send and receive sites at or near every high school in the county that chooses to participate
- Update and expand instructional technology
