Dr. Frost commented that as the Administrator in the room, he believes that having numerous SLO's detracts from the work the faculty could be contributing to the College such as serving on committees.

Mike Paddack and Neil Carpentier-Alting are researching how we are going to implement repeatability on campus. They will report back to the Committee in the near future.

For the new members on the Committee, Jayne reviewed the steps to approve courses in CurricUNET.
