**g. PHIL 1016 – Environment, Culture, and Ethics – Course Update Transfer GE DE**

The course need/justification section of the COR references a Multidisciplinary Environmental Studies Program, which this course is designed for; however, the program has not yet been submitted for approval in CurricUNET. Neil will check with Alison Varty to see if she still intends on proposing this program before moving forward with the approval process for this course.

**h. PHIL 1021 – World Religions: Eastern Cultures – Course Update Transfer GE DE**

This course is currently approved for COS GE Area I-Diversity; although, this information is not mentioned on the proposed COR. Neil will check with the originator, Daniel Kealey, to see if this omission was just an oversight or if the intent was to no longer offer this course as a COS GE diversity option.

**Item 3. Course Approval Procedure**

Eric updated Administrative Procedure No. 4022 (Course Approvals) with the suggested changes made by the Committee. The document was again reviewed by the Committee and they agreed that no further modifications were needed. It was recommended that AP No. 4022 should be forwarded to College Council along with AP No. 4020 once that document has been brought up to date.

**Item 4. Program Approval Procedure**

The Committee reviewed Administrative Procedure No. 4020 (Program and Curriculum Development). The Committee recommended several changes to be made to this document. Eric and Neil will incorporate these amendments and the updated edition of this document will be reviewed again the next scheduled meeting.

**Item 5. Good of the Order**

Dennis Roberts inquired if the College could still offer “experimental” courses without the Chancellor’s Office approval. Eric stated that as of January 1, 2014, colleges no longer had the authority to offer stand-alone courses. But, he did not know if “experimental” and “stand-alone” courses meant the same thing. Eric will research these topics and report back his findings at the next meeting.
