The courses have already been approved by the Chancellor's Office for Yuba and Woodland and therefore Bob expects them to move through the Chancellor's Office for approval quickly. The Committee agreed that having Ms. Korkowski function as the faculty in charge of submitting curriculum for this program until agriculture faculty could be hired would be consistent with the procedures that the Committee will develop for situations like these in which there is no faculty content expert on staff.
