1. Approval of Minutes – May 1, 2017

A motion was made and seconded (Roche/Korkowski) to approve the minutes. The minutes were approved with no corrections.

2. Course Approvals

a. ADJ 9675 – Instructor I – Instructional Methodology – New Course

This is in fact a FIRE course that was put in incorrectly. Mike made the change in CurricUNET and the Curriculum Committee approved the course with the changes.

b. OLAD 0505 – Body Dynamics and the Aging Process II – New Course

The Committee reviewed and approved OLAD 0505.

d. FIRE 9673 – Company Officer 2D – All Risk Command Operations – New Course

Provisional Curriculum Committee approval is pending corrections to the course prerequisites per the Chancellor's Office request.

4. Updates – Mike Graves

Mike informed the Committee that there is a conference call scheduled at 1:00 p.m. on Friday with eLumen. Margie Kurko (a former COS employee) has been assigned as our eLumen representative. The meeting will address the conversion timeline and any questions we might have. After the meeting, we will email Governet and ask for an all field's report that will take about 6 weeks to come back. Those attending are: Mike Graves, Chris Vancil, Mike Tischler, Bart Scott, Dr. Todd Scott, Jodi Dawson and Elaine Eldridge. The goal is that by the time everyone is back in August, we will have everything transitioned over from CurricUNET to eLumen. At that point Mike will begin the eLumen training for all faculty.

5. Other

FIRE 9236, FIRE 9670, FIRE 9672 and FIRE 9674 were returned to the originator by the Coding Reviewer. Elaine informed the Committee that she returned them because of several issues but the main one was they had the same issue with prerequisites as the other four fire courses that were previously returned by the Chancellor's Office. The Committee agreed that the course prerequisites and the course outlines must be updated and corrected per the Chancellor's office comments by Wednesday, May 17th by 5 p.m. otherwise courses will have to be resubmitted in the fall.
