The Committee reviewed and approved the draft of AP/BP 4025 that Mike and Katie composed and made a recommendation to send it forward to the Senate Executive Committee.

4. Other

- The eLumen course outlines cannot be publically viewed by other institutions like they were with CurricUNET. Dr. Greene asked if there is a way to make them public so she doesn't have to print and scan each one for outside institutions to review. Mike will talk to Elaine and report back to the Committee.
- Good progress is being made with the Tech Reviews. Out of 42 courses in the queue we are down to 17.
- The Applied and Technique MUS courses have far too many co-requisites. The Committee recommended sending them back to the originator to remove the co-requisites altogether. The suggestion by the Committee is to modify the Limitation of Enrollment to read: "Qualification by Audition is Required".
- Mike advised Patrice Thatcher-Stephens of the requirements for the ECE Certificates. She is working on them and will resubmit at a later time.
