- Clarification of awards will pull directly to catalog.
- Justification doesn't pull through to the catalog, but catalog description does.
- Term 1,2,3,4 implies a sequence. Not all courses are required in a specific order.
- Sequence vs cycle. eLumen states sequence and not cycle.
- Under each term put "Recommended Sequence, see your counselor or advisor."
- Terms: For specific programs such as Nursing, Paramedic, etc, you can indicate required courses in a sesquence., otherwise see the counseling office for specific course sequencing.
