**2009-2010 Lower Division General Education Requirements**  
(Southern Oregon University and some other universities also accept completed CSUGE)

Completion of all these requirements will permit you to transfer from to any CSU campus without the need, after transfer, to take additional lower-division general education courses. **Areas marked with an (\*) must be completed prior to transfer with a grade of C or better.** For most students, 60 transferable units are required for admission including at least 30 units from this page with a grade of C or better in each course. Make an appointment with an advisor or a counselor to discuss your transfer plans and to determine if there are campus-specific admissions requirements. After transfer you must complete three upper division general education courses.

     **AREA A: ENGLISH LANGUAGE COMMUNICATION AND CRITICAL THINKING**

Complete three courses, one course from each of the following categories.  
(minimum 9 semester / 12 quarter units)

- \*A1. **Oral Communication:** SPCH 1 or 2 or 3.
- \*A2. **Written Communication:** ENGL 1A.
- \*A3. **Critical Thinking:** ENGL 1C or PHIL 4.

     **AREA B: SCIENTIFIC INQUIRY AND QUANTITATIVE REASONING**

Complete three courses, one course from each of the categories B1, B2, B4. One of the B1 or B2 courses must have a lab to satisfy the B3 lab requirement. Lab courses are underlined.  
(minimum 9 semester / 12 quarter units)

- B1. **Physical Science:** ASTR 1; CHEM 1A, 1B, 3A, 3B, 7; GEOG 1; GEOL 13, 14, 16, 17, 20, 34; PHSC 16; PHYS 1, 2A, 2B, 4A, 4B, 4C, 10.
- B2. **Life Science:** ANTH 2; BIO 1, 2, 3, 5, 5+5L, 6, 7, 10, 12A, 12B, 14, 15, 16.
- B3. **Laboratory:** Any underlined course from category B1 or B2.
- \*B4. **Math:** 2, 4, 5A, 5B, 5C, 7, 8, 10, 25.

Complete three courses with at least three units from category C1 and C2.  
(minimum 9 semester / 12 quarter units)

- C2. **Humanities:** ASL 20, 21; ARAB 1, 2; ENGL 1B, 12, 13, 18, 28, 36, 44A, 44B, 45, 46A, 46B, 47, 48; FREN 1, 2; GER 1; HUM 1, 5; PHIL 1, 3, 9, 10A, 10B, 12, 14, 15, 20, 21; SPAN 1, 2, 3, 4.
- C. **Arts or Humanities:** Complete an additional course from C1 or C2. \_\_\_\_\_
