Prerequisites:

1. Must be eligible for admission to the University.
2. Eligibility for admission to the RN to BSN Nursing major:
 - Graduation from an associate degree program in nursing (can be in final semester)
 - Minimum of 54 transferrable non-nursing units (GE certification courses, Nursing Prerequisites & Corequisites). Up to 61.5 units may be needed, depending of # of transferrable nursing units available for transfer
 - Completion of CSUC lower division GE requirements
 - Completion of all CSUC nursing prerequisite courses (Anatomy, Physiology, Microbiology, Chemistry, Oral Communication, Written Communication, Critical Thinking, & Statistics) with minimum "C" grade
 - Cumulative GPA of 3.0 (will accept most recent 60 units); 3.0 in Nursing Courses required if applying prior to graduation
 - Must be accepted into the RN to BSN Program by Chico State School of Nursing before applying to Chico
