## ADJUNCT INSTRUCTOR POOL

### NURSING (YREKA) NUTRITION (YREKA) WELDING (BUTTE VALLEY/DORRIS)

**We are actively seeking a pool of instructors for Nursing, Nutrition and Welding Adjunct Instructors however, any discipline applications will be accepted on an on-going basis, and are encouraged to apply.**

#### Minimum Qualifications

The College of the Siskiyous follows the minimum qualification guidelines set forth in the "Minimum Qualifications for Faculty and Administrators in California Community Colleges."

1. Academic disciplines require a Master's degree in the discipline in which the course is offered (or a closely related discipline or the equivalent). *Note: Applicants applying under "equivalency" must provide detailed written documentation explaining how their academic preparation is equivalent to the degrees listed by completing an Equivalency Determination Application.*
2. Vocational, technical, and application courses require an Associate's degree plus 6 years of professional experience or a Baccalaureate degree plus 2 years of professional experience.
3. To qualify for a teaching position, all applicants must demonstrate sensitivity to and understanding of the diverse academic, socioeconomic, cultural, disability, and ethnic backgrounds of community college students.

**Associate Degree Nursing Instructor:** Master's degree from a regionally accredited college or university in nursing, education, or administration **OR** Bachelor's in nursing **AND** Master's in health education or health science **OR** the equivalent in accordance with statewide minimum qualifications **OR** the minimum qualifications as set by the Board of Registered Nursing, whichever is higher.

#### **Vocational Nursing Instructor:**

- Associate's degree from a regionally accredited college or university.
- Hold a current active California license as a Vocational Nurse or Registered Nurse; **AND** a valid California Community College teaching credential; **OR** have completed one year fulltime teaching experience in a state accredited or approved registered nursing, vocational or practical nursing, or psychiatric technician school within the last five years; **OR** meet community college or state university teaching requirements in California
- Minimum of six years experience as a Licensed Vocational or Registered Nurse within the last five years.
- Successful candidate will have completed or be currently attending a course in teaching offered by an accredited school.
- Sensitivity to and understanding of the diverse academic, socioeconomic, cultural and ethnic backgrounds of community college students.

**Nutrition Instructor:** Master's Degree from an accredited college or university in nutrition, dietetics, or dietetics and food administration **OR** Bachelor's in any of the above **AND** Master's in chemistry, public health, or family and consumer studies/home economics, **OR** The equivalent.

**Welding Instructor:** Bachelor's Degree from an accredited college or university **AND** two years of experience, **OR** any Associate's Degree and six years of experience. **OR** The equivalent.

*Note: Applicants applying under "equivalency" must provide an equivalency application explaining how their academic preparation is equivalent to the degrees listed*

#### **Salary**

The salary range is \$49.85 to \$63.26 per hour depending upon education.  
The salary is \$30.31 per hour for Adult Education. (Non-Credit)

#### **Benefits**

Adjunct employees have the choice of two retirement plans. CalSTRS (California State Teachers Retirement System), and APPLE (Accumulation Program for Part-Time and Limited Service Employees.)

### **Application Procedure**

Applications are accepted on an on-going basis. To be considered for an adjunct position, candidates **must** fill out an application for adjunct employment and **attach the required documents listed below**. You may attach any varied certifications that will help us assess your qualifications. Applicants must submit **ALL** required documents to be considered for employment. **All materials submitted are for this position only, and become property of the District. Materials will not be returned, copied, or considered for other openings. Only completed application packets will be forwarded to the Area Dean. Candidates are responsible for any costs associated with interviews.**

  - a. Transcripts of any college level work with degrees posted. (Copies are acceptable for application. The successful candidate must provide original transcripts upon hiring. Foreign transcripts **must** include a U.S. evaluation **and** translation, at the time of application.)
  - b. Copy of your California Community College teaching credential **if** this is your method of meeting the minimum qualifications.
  - c. Letters from previous employers that verify your occupational experience including dates of employment, whether full-time or part-time, and duties and responsibilities.

### **Screening Process**

**\*Applications are accepted on an on-going basis for the listed positions and in any other discipline throughout the year.**

**Applications for adjunct teaching positions will be used to create a pool of qualified applicants for future hiring. Applications will be kept on file for one year.**

### **Conditions of Employment**

Employees must satisfy all the pre-employment requirements prior to appointment that include, but are not limited to, tuberculosis clearance (EC 87408.6), fingerprint processing, and verification of their legal right to work in the United States.
