### **REGISTER TODAY FOR LEVEL III RESERVE OFFICER AT COS**

Weed / COS –Are you interested in a career in law enforcement? “All over California, agencies are hiring law enforcement personnel,” said Glenn (Tad) White, Deputy – Siskiyou County Sheriff’s Office and ADJ Program Coordinator through an agreement with the Sheriff’s Office and the District. “We currently need students in our Level III Police Officer Academy (ADJ 14) class for the fall and PC 832 Reserve Officer course (ADJ 12A),” he continued. White has over twenty-two years of law enforcement and Educational Teaching and administration experience. The ADJ program now also features expanded Reserve Training staff including patrol officers, detectives, administrative personnel, personnel from the District Attorney’s Office, and field experts. In addition, the Sheriff’s Office has donated new upgraded safety and duty equipment, crime scene investigation equipment, and two fully outfitted patrol vehicles that are used to familiarize students with all aspects of field patrol and investigation.

**Level III Reserve Officer Training (ADJ 14 / #8203 / 9 units / 166 hours)** will begin August 17, 2009 and will end December 17, 2009. The class will meet Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday evenings, 6 to 10 p.m. at the Weed Campus in the Tactical Training Center (TTC) room 32-102.

**PC 832 (ADJ 12A / #8335 / 3 units)** will begin September 8, 2009 and will continue until September 29, 2009. The class will meet Monday through Friday from 6 to 9 p.m. in the Tactical Training Center (TTC) room 32-102. This course includes all subject matter, learning goals, and performance objectives as required by the California Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST).

The Reserve Officer Training Program at College of the Siskiyous fulfills all the requirements for an individual to be certified as a Level III and Level II reserve police officer for the State of California. A student who successfully completes both Level III and Level II reserve programs will have completed 1/2 of the basic academy instruction (445 hours). A student could then attend a participating academy and take the balance of the hours to fulfill the total 664 hourly requirements of the Basic Academy (Level I). Both reserve programs require a significant hourly commitment on the part of the student
