College of the Siskiyous is a two-year accredited California Community College. The main campus is in Weed, California, with a second campus in Yreka, California. COS is the only institution of higher education in Siskiyou County.

Education for Economic Opportunity

College of the Siskiyous is Siskiyou County's primary source for job training and technology career skills. Local companies send their employees to COS to upgrade their job skills. More than half of the students are enrolled in career-oriented programs. Students may choose to graduate with an Associate Degree, transfer credits to four-year institutions, earn Vocational Certificates or completed a Bachelor Degree. Many also select specific courses to meet personal goals.

Artistic Center

The College offers a Performing Arts Center. Its theater is the largest in the County, and is equipped with excellent sound and lighting systems. National touring companies as well as local schools and community groups use the COS Theater for their performances. College music and theater events attract a large local audience each year.

21st Century Goals

The College's Strategic Plan offers timely, well-targeted support to the changing needs of Siskiyou County.

The Plan includes:

- Providing the equipment, curriculum, and faculty expertise needed to meet changing job-training requirements and to help local businesses compete in a global economy.
