

## Scholarships for Continuing Students (Currently Enrolled)

### **\$1,000—Penny Ordway Memorial Art**

Criteria: Second year COS art student who has completed 30 credit units, with demonstrated scholastic achievement and demonstrated financial need.

### **\$1,000—Re-Entry**

Criteria: Female single parent, displaced homemaker, or widow seeking educational or vocational training to enter the workforce, enrolling in a minimum of 6 academic units. No limit on number of years applicant has been out of the work force. Community service encouraged but not required. Must meet with a counselor to develop an educational plan before scholarship award funds are released. Must maintain a 2.5 GPA; if less than 2.5, may appeal to the Foundation Scholarship Committee with special conditions. Scholarship is “renewable” for the second year without reapplication if GPA is maintained and academic major or vocation is declared.

### **\$750—Whetstine Family Memorial**

Criteria: Full-time, spring-semester student continuing at COS for a consecutive year, with 3.5 GPA in science. Note: Must submit written recommendation by a Mathematics or Science instructor and demonstrate that potential goals and ambitions are committed to education.

### **\$750—Paul Dawson Memorial Geology and Natural Resource Program**

Criteria: Full-time, second semester student continuing at COS for a consecutive year, with a 3.0 GPA. Must have taken or be enrolled in a Geology course and be pursuing a career in Environmental/Natural Resources.

### **\$500—Victor J. Thompson, M.D. Memorial**

Criteria: Full-time continuing student who plans to major, or is currently majoring, in a healthcare-related program (i.e. Paramedic/EMT, Nursing, Athletic Training).

### **\$500— Kenneth Beatty Memorial Biology**

Criteria: Full or part-time spring semester student continuing at COS for a consecutive year, majoring in biology, with a 3.5 GPA. Preference given to those studying Ecology, Botany, Zoology and general Biology.

### **\$500—Kandace Kruger Memorial Music**

Criteria: Full-time spring semester music student continuing at COS for a consecutive year, with a 2.5 GPA. Must have participated in COS Concert Choir(s) during first year; must continue participation through second year.

### **\$500—McCaleb “Mac” DeCausmaker Memorial**

Criteria: Siskiyou County high school graduate enrolled in the spring semester COS Fire Fighter 1 Academy, with a 2.5 GPA. 30 hours of community service with the spring Fire Fighter Academy required. Note: Must submit one page letter detailing reasons for enrolling in the COS Fire Fighter 1 Academy at College of the Siskiyous.

### **\$500—Eric Hall Memorial**

Criteria: Full-time continuing student who plans to enroll, or is enrolled, in the COS Fire Science Program or Fire Academy, with a 2.5 GPA.

### **\$500—Elin Greta Marrs Memorial**

Criteria: Full-time Art student continuing at COS for a consecutive year.

### **\$250—Patricia K. Thompson Memorial**

Criteria: Spring-semester student continuing at COS for a consecutive year in the areas of English, Creative Writing or Drama. Must have successfully completed English 1A or 1B, with a 3.0 GPA.

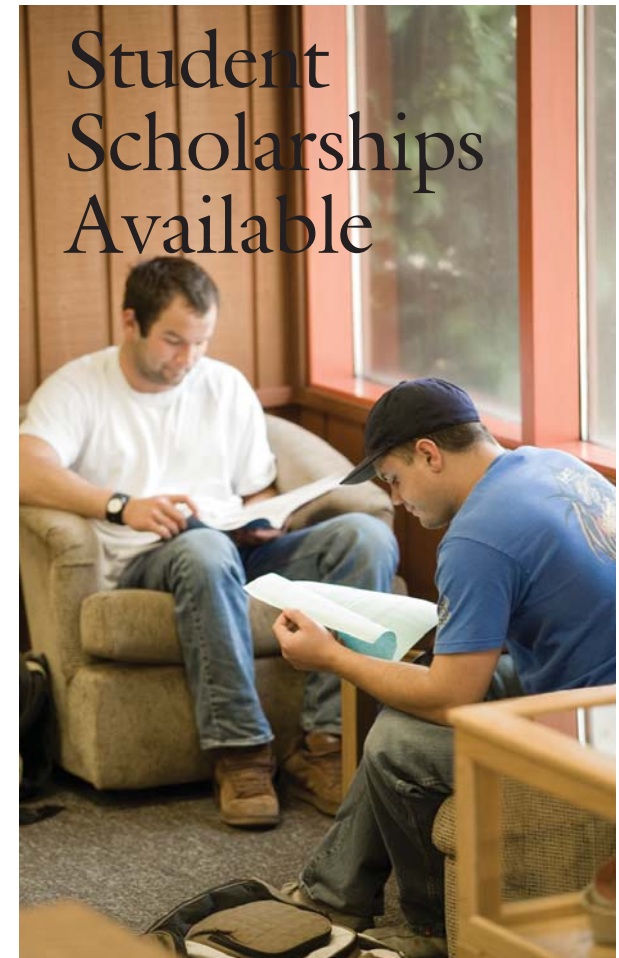

## Apply for Scholarships

The College of the Siskiyous (COS) Foundation offers a variety of scholarships to current Siskiyou County high school seniors, re-entry students, and continuing students enrolling at COS. Applications are available January 1 through March 15 at the COS Foundation Office and the Financial Aid Office on the Weed Campus, the Yreka Campus, Siskiyou County high schools, and online: <http://www.siskiyous.edu/publicrelations>

Completed applications must be submitted to the COS Weed Campus Financial Aid Office by March 15. Please read the criteria for each scholarship carefully and submit all required materials. Incomplete applications will be rejected

### Scholarships for Siskiyou County Graduating High School Seniors Enrolling at COS

#### **\$3,000—Siskiyou Scholar Award**

Criteria: Enrolling in 12 COS academic credit units, maintaining a 3.5 GPA in college course work, and fulfilling 5 hours/week of community service in the COS Foundation Office or the Foundation's retail business, "The Eagles Nest." Note: All high school students applying for COS Scholarships are considered for this award.

#### **\$1,000—COS Foundation High School Scholarships**

Criteria: Enrolling in 12 COS academic credit units, with a 3.0 high school GPA. Note: Five \$1,000 scholarships are offered each year.

#### **\$500—Todd Edelson Memorial**

Criteria: Enrolling in 12 COS academic credit units, with a 3.0 high school GPA.

#### **\$500—Donald Herfindahl Memorial**

Criteria: Enrolling as a full-time COS student, with a 2.0 high school GPA. Note: Must be a Yreka High School senior.

#### **\$500—Shasta Valley Rotary**

Criteria: Enrolling as a full-time COS student, with a 3.0 high school GPA. Note: Must be a Yreka High School senior.

#### **\$500—Harry Crebbin Memorial**

Criteria: Enrolling as a full-time COS student and planning to major in business.

### Scholarships for Siskiyou County Graduating High School Seniors Enrolling at COS or for COS Continuing Students

#### **\$1,000—Osher Initiative**

Criteria: Attending fall and spring semesters with 24 or more "degree applicable" semester units (or the equivalent) at the time of the initial scholarship disbursement, enrolling in 6 or more units during all terms in which the award remains active, and receiving a CCC Board of Governor's Fee Waiver. Note: Five \$1,000 scholarships are offered each year.

#### **\$1,000—Neil Schanker Memorial Biology**

Criteria: Intending to transfer to a four-year college and majoring in a biology-related field, with a 3.0 GPA for high school or college course work. Special consideration given to applicants whose emphasis is in Ecology, Zoology, Botany or Environmental Science.

#### **\$1,000—Charles Byrd Memorial**

Criteria: Enrolling full-time and majoring in Administration of Justice or Fire Technology, with a 2.5 GPA for high school or college course work.

#### **\$1,000—Harry Crebbin Memorial**

Criteria: Continuing COS student with 24 COS units completed, intending to transfer to a four-year college as a Business major, with a 3.0 GPA for college course work. Note: Must be a Siskiyou County high school graduate.

#### **\$1,000—WRBA Paul Prescott**

Criteria: Enrolling full or part-time student majoring in power generation.

#### **\$700—Larry & Rosalie Meyer**

Criteria: Enrolling full-time in any healthcare-related program, (i.e. Paramedic/EMT, Nursing, Athletic Training), with a 3.0 GPA for high school or college course work, and demonstrating financial need.

#### **\$500—A.T. "Thorn" Cumings Memorial**

Criteria: Enrolling full or part-time, majoring in Administration of Justice, with a 2.8 GPA for high school or college course work.

#### **\$500—Dunsmuir VFW Post 4718 Memorial**

Criteria: Enrolling full or part-time, with a 3.0 GPA for high school or college course work. Note: Must be a South Siskiyou County High School graduate who is also the child or grandchild of a military veteran or active duty military personnel.

#### **\$500—George F. Mattos Music**

Criteria: Enrolling full-time, majoring in music, with a 3.0 GPA for high school or college course work.

#### **\$250—Robert Sanchez**

Criteria: Enrolling full-time, majoring in Physical Therapy or Athletic Training, with a 2.5 GPA for high school or college course work. Note: Preference given to a Siskiyou County high school graduate.

#### **\$250—Roger Ellis Legacy**

Criteria: Enrolling full-time, majoring in Physical Education, participating on a COS athletic team, with a 2.0 GPA for high school or college course work.

#### **\$250—Weed Family Memorial**

Criteria: Graduate of Gazelle Elementary School or a direct descendent of Abner E. Weed (founder of the City of Weed, CA), with a 2.0 GPA for high school or college course work. Note: Preference given to students demonstrating financial need.

#### **\$250—Don Stensaas Family**

Criteria: Enrolling full or part-time, majoring in Speech, Psychology, or Counseling, with a 3.0 GPA for high school or college course work.

#### **\$200—Mount Shasta Garden Club**

Criteria: Enrolling full or part-time, majoring in Horticulture, with a 2.5 GPA for high school or college course work.

### Scholarships for Continuing Students (Currently Enrolled)

#### **\$1,000—Moran Family Nursing**

Criteria: COS student enrolled in the Vocational Nursing or Registered Nursing (LVN to RN Step-Up) Programs with a 3.5 GPA.
