Single author:

Four or more authors (may use phrase et al. or list all authors' names as they appear on title page):

Beals, Mike, et al. *Victorian Homes of California*. Sacramento: Renovation Press, 1999. Print.

Editor:

Dohrn, Denise, ed. *Leather and Lace: Hot Times on a Harley*. New York: Wiley & Sons, 1993. Print.

Encyclopedia or Dictionary:

"Sonata." *Encyclopedia Britannica*. 15th ed. 1997. Print.

Organization as author:

Bank of Boston. *Bank by Remote Control*. Boston: Bank of Boston, 1997. Print.

Unknown author:

Oxford Essential World Atlas. New York: Oxford UP, 1996. Print.

Work in an anthology:

Malouf, David. "The Kyogle Line." *The Oxford Book of Travel Stories*. Ed. Patricia Craig. 2nd ed. Oxford: Oxford UP, 1996. 390-96. Print.

Two or more works from same anthology:

Dictionary of Quotations

Author of Quote. "Section Heading." *Title of Reference Book*. Edition. Year. Medium of Publication.

Example:

Franklin, Ben. "Education." *Dictionary of Quotes*. 3rd ed. 2003. Print.

Online Dictionary of Quotations

Author. "Article Title." *Homepage*. Sponsor, Date of Posting. Web. Date of access.
