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## Academic Senate Executive Meeting Minutes

November 7, 2017 (Convened at 8:08am) in DLC Rm #8

### A. Discussion Items / Action Items

- ❖ Distance Learning (DL) committee is in the process of examining the Online Education Initiative (OEI) Rubric to guide the DL Committee's development of COS Online Course Standards, Online Instructor/Course Evaluations, and Online Student Survey
- ❖ Maria Fernandez from the DL committee has asked the Senate Exec to recommend to the Academic Senate adopting @One's "Standards for Quality Online Teaching" document as COS Best Practices for the Online Environment (Item will be referenced in the DL Handbook)
  - The DL committee is considering proposing that instructors must submit their online courses 2 to 4 weeks prior to the start of class to insure all standards are met
  - The Senate Exec went through each of the standards in the document and made a notation if there were questions or issues regarding certain requirements
    1. Standard 1, Point 3 – The instructor incorporates a variety of tools that meet the various learning needs of his/her students.
      - a. Does this apply to individual assignments/tests or to the course as a whole?
    2. Standard 2, Point 2 – The instructor uses a variety of tools for communicating with students, delivering content, assessing student learning, and *analyzing effective teaching*
      - a. How would you analyze effective teaching?
    3. Standard 3, Points 2 & 3 – The instructor promotes active learning through collaborative activities; The instructor facilitates and monitors appropriate student-student interactions
      - a. Do these standards require that you do discussions in your online courses?

4. Standard 6, Point 2 – The instructor includes accessible material, including multi-media
  - a. Do you have to incorporate movies/videos in your online course?
5. Standard 8; Point 1 – The instructor uses course tools and tracking data to monitor student participation and performance
  - a. How will DL assess this aspect if they examine online courses prior to them being taught?
6. Standard 9; Point 1 – The instructor attends workshops and/or conferences to stay current in distance education trends, theories, and tools
  - a. Will COS provide opportunities for DL workshops to fulfill this standard?
7. Maria should clarify to the Senate if this document is approved, when it be implemented?
  - a. Also, how will DL committee evaluate an online course to see if it meets standards?
  - b. Chris will meet with Maria to discuss these issues.
