Thoroughly review SLO manual, this is the core of our process.

Create guiding principles to aid in decision-making.

Assessments need to be meaningful, more than just checking boxes.

Develop process with define steps.

Determine scope of process, what is our goal for next year? What needs to be done?

ISER report due Summer 2022. What is sort of data is expected. Other expectations?

Goal 1: Everyone assess one assessment.

Address needed support for SLO committee.

Suggest SLO committee become an Academic Senate Standing Committee.

- Stipends for adjunct faculty

- Flex training for full-time faculty

- Institutional support

How to use “Expected SLO performance” in COR

Canvas integrated after Curriculum has been created.

Canvas uses a defined window of information for student privacy.

SLO mapping

Requires Programs to be entered into eLumen.

Who is ensuring Information is correct? Check in with administration.

Didn't we do some of this work? How do we retain this info.

SLO assessment

Create rubrics.

Needs to happen at the beginning of the semester.

Who has access to SLO module? Faculty and Coordinators, Deans, and Directors.

SLO reporting choices, individual students and collective numbers.

Ability to take notes and provide narrative.

Every SLO assessed in a 3 year cycle.

Planned Assessments

Faculty able to score students in a few different ways; manually by hand, upload spreadsheet, use canvas partnership. Recommended to learn manual method first.

Build rubric in eLumen first.

Mass Sync should happen at census. Week 4

Can share data at and above course level.
