- 1. Need for inquiry at COS
  - Accreditation and "checking boxes," previous accreditation visit made assessment a #1 priority (centralized data (eLumen), increase quality and quantity of assessment)
  - o Improve program review
  - Evidence to support resource allocation
  - $\circ$   $\;$  Culture of assessment promotes transparency and learning from each other  $\;$
  - $\circ$  Value in collaboration student support, administration, noncredit, CTS, LAS, etc.
  - Equity need to be able to analyze disaggregated data at the course and program level
  - \* CBA focuses on data collection, not conversation about how we can use data to make improvements

Previous efforts – pass/fail rates, not much discussion, talked about planning assessment, reworking SLOs, turn over in administration, consistent assessment for 2 or 3 years (in Excel docs, Curricunet)

Pain points – data not correct, too much work to assess all SLOs each semester Emaly – guidance classes tied to SLOs, we don't have guidance classes
