Committee Goals AY 23-24:

### Assessment philosophy:

- Help getting people on board.
- There may be resistance until people see how these conversations can help improve our courses

#### Faculty concerns about assessment:

- Take a bunch of time and not be purposeful
- We don't want eLumen driving processes
- We already have an SLO manual
- C-ID objectives versus SLOs

## Proposed assessment plan:

- Ed seems like it will work fine for academic and activity courses for athletics
- General agreement that it seems like a good starting place
