2. DISCUSSION ITEMS

 - iv) Meeting with Mark F. met with on 9/14, supported funds for data visualization and stipend contract for Caroline for her committee service
 - v) Needs Assessment haven't looked at results yet, bring to next meeting, maybe set up a workgroup to identify professional development activity, would like to do an optional flex session in spring (on Zoom too or entirely?), will send out again to see if we can get more responses, will also send to pt faculty
 - vi) Data upload update not yet, hopefully soon, support ticket with eLumen, rep said it should be resolved late this week
- c) Review potential committee goals for the year:
 - i) "Get all the parts in place" for faculty assessment complete construction of the assessment process mostly Liz and Ann
 - ii) Approve an assessment philosophy in Senate discuss questions from document tackle a couple at a time entire committee
 - iii) Facilitate one professional development workshop in Flex identify a cycle of PD for each year entire committee
 - iv) SAO outcome? facilitate development of SAO outcomes and an assessment process
- d) Dialogue Days: add an additional Flex day--Pros/Cons, alternative options will be bringing this to the FA meeting, college has done this in the past, stopped when curricinet went away, 3 hours, will also bring to Instruction Council

a) Mapping in eLumen training (30 mins) - Explained why we need to do mapping to indirectly assess PSLOs and GESLOs and barriers to getting mapping doe (permissions in eLumen), did a demo, Leigh and Shirley will do their courses and report back on how it goes, will meet with Ed separately and ask that he do the same
