## **Approval of Minutes**

Kyle moved to approve the August 27, 2025, meeting minutes. Shannamar seconded. Approved with one abstention.

## **Discussion / Action Items**

- Welcome new member: Bliss Friedman
- Brown Act requirements
  - Reviewed the circumstances under which the Brown Act must be followed and requirements of the Brown Act.
  - We will list the Yreka campus room 2, as a location so that members attending remotely from there can vote and be counted toward quorum. Our regular meeting location is DLC 4.
- Insights and Data updates
  - Transitioning to a new CSM.
  - Ann, Liz, and JT met to go over the dashboard. We are working on getting 24-25 data from eLumen to include in the dashboard along with 23-24, so that our dashboard will include the entire 3-year cycle.
  - Course codes and names in Canvas have been switched, which should help ensure the correct outcomes are being pushed into courses by Insights.
  - We are working on ways to track assessment planning and completion. We can track completion based on data that ends up in the datalake.
- Assessment Workgroups. Identify committee members who can provide training support for faculty.
  - o Committee members will attend the workgroups if they are available.
  - We will add a morning session the following week to accommodate coaches. There will also need to be additional workgroups for PT faculty.
- Committee Membership and Goals for 2025-26
  - New goal "Identify ways to increase dialogue around assessment." One option could be to create a pre-approved flex activity for half a flex day. Three hours seems like a long time to talk about assessment.
  - Host a professional development workshop on outcomes. Topics could include objectives versus outcomes, how course assignments and activities map to outcomes and objectives.
