Child Development Permits Definition

- Child Development Permits are issued by the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing. Credentialing and the Early Education Permits are part of the ongoing reorganization of the California Departments of Education and Social Services.
 - Not all employers require a Child Development Permit.
 - State Preschools and Head Start Programs typically require Permits.
 - Some Programs' qualifications are based on Title 22 Standards.
 - Many Independent Programs use Title 22 Standards. NOT TONIGHT 😊

The Application Process

- Child Development Permits are issued at 6 levels. Look at the Matrix.
- All fee for all Credentials or Permits is \$100.00 plus a \$2.50 for online processing.
 - Hold your horses. 😊
- Live Scan clearance is required to apply for a Permit. This costs \$49.00

- Permits must be renewed every 5 years. This also costs \$100.00.
 - Please Continue to hold your horses.
- Permits can be upgraded to a higher level. The fee for this is ½ the original fee within the first three years.

Site Supervisor	Required: AA (or 60 units) in ECE including: Required: 1002 Child Development OR 1999 Human Development/1003 Child, Family and Community OR 2500 Family Relationships and Parenting/1500 Introduction to Curriculum Plus: Five more 3-unit classes Plus: 2501 Administration AND 2525 Staffing=6 administrative units Plus: 2527=2 units of Adult Supervision

NOTE:

- In Option 1 all levels except Assistant Teacher require experience. See Permit Matrix.
- There are Alternative “Option 2” Qualifications. See Permit Matrix.
- There are 5 Year Renewal Requirements. See Permit Matrix.

CDTC Educational Support Grants

In past school years—if you were EMPLOYED in early education programs—while you were taking classes at College of the Siskiyou, you have been encouraged to complete Student Profiles in order to receive up to \$26/per unit for the classes you were taking that counted toward your degree. You may remember my constant nagging about “Complete your Profile”/ “Submit your Profile”/ “Please be patient while we get your stipend funds to you...”.

After last year Child Development Training Consortium reorganized their practices and I was no longer the coordinator for COS. For a while it looked as if they were going to continue to support students is somewhat the same way.

But, honestly, I lost track of their changes-even though I was keeping track of the classes you took, and their processes changed.

CDTC now offers individual Educational Support Grants which you can apply for directly through CDTC.

The Students' Attributes and Qualifications for these grants are slightly different than those for the previous student support stipend 😊:

- The grants are available to a broader range of students
 - Priority 1: Those EMPLOYED in early education programs including Licensed Family Childcare and also ENROLLED in CCC ECE classes.
 - Priority 2: Those ENROLLED in a 3-unit PRACTICUM CLASS!
- Grant Applications are closed for 2020-2021.
- It looks as if they will reopen in August 2021 for the 2021-2022 year.
- Now paying \$46/unit.
