1. Fees include:

- a. California residents: \$46 per unit
- b. Western Undergraduate Exchange or Oregon Exchange: \$69 per unit
- c. Oregon Students: \$184 per unit (\$138 Oregon Good Neighbor + \$46 Standard Enrollment Fee per unit)
- d. Out-of-state Students: \$353 per unit (\$307 Nonresident + \$46 Standard Enrollment Fee per unit)
- e. Health (All Students): \$20 per semester

- f. Student Activity Fee (All Students): \$1 per unit (max \$5 per semester)
- g. Student Center Fee (All Students): \$1 per unit (max \$5 per semester)
- h. Student Representation Fee (All Students): \$2 per semester

2. Direct v. Indirect Charges

- a. Lodge and meal plan rates are charged by COS directly to the student's account.
- b. Food and Housing is estimated (not charged by school) for a student living:
 - i. off-campus with roommates, e.g. rent charged by landlord, groceries, utilities etc.
 - ii. at parent-owned residence; e.g. portion of household costs that support students (room, meals, utilities etc.).

3. Food & Housing Breakdown

- a. On Campus double occupancy dorm housing cost includes utilities, cable, internet, and \$3,500 in meal points per semester

- b. Living with parent or off Campus are estimated typical local living expenses for budget purposes.
 - i. Consider this what one might pay for housing and food if not a student (using earning to pay bills without aid).
 - ii. These will **not** appear on your bill as they do with Lodge residents.

4. Includes clothing, laundry, personal care, gifts, recreation, medical, etc.

5. Includes travel to and from parent's residence and transportation to and from class and work (e.g. gasoline).
