

## College of the Siskiyous Foundation Holiday Craft Fair Guidelines for Participation Friday & Saturday, December 1st & 2nd, 2023

• All crafters / vendors who wish to participate in the COS Holiday Craft Fair must have a current California Seller's Permit Number. If you already have a seller's permit, please include it on the registration form where noted. If you do not have a seller's permit you will need to apply for one as soon as possible. Visit the Board of Equalization Office in Redding, CA to apply in person or go to their website: <a href="www.taxes.ca.gov/">www.taxes.ca.gov/</a> and search for CA seller's permit. There is no cost to apply for a seller's permit.

All vendors registered for the COS Holiday Craft Fair must have their seller's permit number on file in the Foundation Office no later than November 17, 2023 and should bring their permit with them to the COS Holiday Craft Fair.

- Spaces are \$75 per 10' x 10' space. **Refunds will be made on any cancellation prior to November 17, 2023**. Once the COS Holiday Craft Fair begins, **refunds should not be expected**. Crafters on waiting list will be notified if a space becomes available on a first-come, first-served basis.
- All vendors will be notified as to whether or not they have been accepted to participate in the COS Holiday Craft Fair.
- All items sold must be handcrafted, handmade or homegrown by the vendor. Commercially produced products may not be sold. Crafters are asked to submit an example of their work when submitting registration forms. Photographs will not be returned, but will be kept on file in the Foundation Office for publicity purposes. If a vendor has previously participated in the COS Holiday Craft Fair, photos are not necessary unless new items have been added. All applications will be reviewed carefully to prevent saturation of like items. Please note: The Foundation reserves the right to deny crafter participation if there is question regarding the validity of the product(s).
- No tables and chairs will be provided.
- Crafters are asked to check in with the craft fair manager when arriving so they may be shown to their space.
- Crafters may set up between 1:00 5:00 p.m. on Friday, December 1 in the school gym. Set up **must** be completed prior to the doors opening to the public at 5:00 p.m. on Friday.
- There will be a snack bar open on Friday and Saturday for dinner, breakfast, and lunch.
- Due to the unpredictable weather conditions in Siskiyou County, we ask that you take into consideration the weather forecast and be prepared for any conditions that may arise.
- If an emergency arises or weather becomes a safety issue for you, and you need to leave, please notify the market manager that you are leaving.
- You DO NOT have to be vaccinated or have a negative COVID test to participate and masks are NOT required.
- Crafters must stay within the 10' x 10' space.
- Crafters may not change or trade spaces with other crafters unless authorization is received from the craft fair manager.
- We do not offer/provide electricity. If you need electricity, you need to provide your own battery-operated devices.

- Crafters are asked to donate a gift to the COS Foundation at the end of the COS Holiday Craft
  Fair. Gifts are used by the Foundation as auction items at the Foundation's Scholarship Dinner
  and Auction. Funds raised from the sale of these gifts are used to support student scholarships.
- The COS Public Relations Office will advertise the event with:
  - Weekly display ads in all local newspapers for three weeks prior to event
  - o Press releases and ads in Klamath Falls & Medford, OR; Redding, CA, newspapers
  - Radio announcements on Siskiyou County stations throughout the months of October and November
  - o Advertising on public access TV channels
  - o Flyers will be placed on campus, and sent to libraries, chambers, local motels and restaurants.
  - O All crafters are sent a packet of flyers to post in places in which you frequent and shop.
