- € **Activities:** Vendors are prohibited from engaging in any activity that involves body" puncturing, including but not limited to piercing of ears, noses, tongues, or any other body" part, tattooing or any similar act that breaks the skin in any fashion.
- € **Items:** Do not sell or attempt to sell, market, advertise, give away, or have in your" possession: illegal drugs or drug paraphernalia, medicines, nutritional supplements, alcohol," polystyrene foam disposable food service ware including cups and food containers, candy," stolen property, poppers, fireworks, firearms, weapons, switchblades, fixed blades of 2 ½" inches or more, and/or any other illegal items.
