#### Item 2. **Committee Reports**

Ms. Slabaugh reported Emily Anderson-Moser, Grant Development Officer, is working on two grants, Bank of America and Big Lots, which will be submitted under the Foundation's tax ID number. If funded for both grants, it will help those students who are experiencing a financial hardship.

# b) Executive & Board Governance -

- i. Regular Monthly Foundation Board Meetings Ms. Slabaugh reported the Board of Trustees have changed their meetings to the third Tuesday of the month. Therefore, the Foundation needs to change its meeting day. The Board decided to move the Foundation meetings to the second Tuesday of each month.

#### Item 9: College / Campus Update

Dr. Schoonmaker provided the following update:

- California has been in a 'State of Emergency' since March 5. Since this time, the College's Incident Management Team (IMT) meets twice a week to discuss COVID-19 related issues. In early June, two COS employees tested positive for COVID-19 and are off work until they recover. The custodians are doing a deep clean for five days to stop the spread.
- Upward Bound and Cadets in the Law Enforcement Academy are on campus this summer.
- Athletics is waiting for the State to decide whether fall sports will be held in the spring or continue as normal. The deadline for this decision is July 17<sup>th</sup>.
- The College is preparing for face to face, online, and hybrid classes to be offered this fall.
- Dr. Schoonmaker has signed over 500 letters for admission to COS.
- Siskiyou Media Council did a great job producing the COS Graduation event. Available online for viewing.
- The College is moving forward on the housing project to build more housing up to 300 students. We will save money by taking advantage of the low interest rates right now.
- The Shasta Regional Community Foundation approved our grant for a new projector for the Theater. The grant amount is for \$37,315.
- The Theater project is still in the state budget. The planning process has already begun.
