This week's Updates:

 bathrooms: We have ordered hooks and shelves and they will be installed once
 received. Regarding decorations, we would like student input and hope to speak to ASB

- Why did the bathrooms in student center get converted to gender neutral? As mentioned in last month's response to this comment, the men's bathroom was not ADA compliant due to space and was slated for conversion into a single stall. For both the Men's and Women's bathrooms, there was a previous situation related to safety and minors' use of the bathrooms.
- Where are the vending machines? Some of the vending machines were removed due to the vendor company canceling their contract with the College due to lack of use/funds from the vending machines.
