- **Reminder:** As a friendly reminder, while the District does not have a formal dress code for staff, we as District employees are the front-facing representatives of College of the Siskiyous. - **Mill Fire Survey:** Researchers from the University of Oregon are asking for your help in providing feedback on wildfire communication and evacuation processes in areas impacted by recent wildfire events. They are interviewing residents and professionals to discuss diverse experiences with wildfire events and mechanisms for improving wildfire information and communication in the future. - **Workplace Violence Prevention Program (WVPP) Draft:** The WVPP Draft can be accessed in mySiskiyous in the Health and Safety area. The WVPP includes a section on bullying which is defined as: A form of aggressive behavior in which someone intentionally and repeatedly causes another person injury or discomfort. Bullying can take the form of physical contact, psychological abuse, or more subtle actions such as:
 - *Disseminating defamatory statements*
 - *Circulating negative information*
 - *Gossiping with ill intent*
 - *Sharing false or unflattering stories to damage someone's reputation*If you witness or are a victim of bullying, you can submit a report via the [Workplace Violence Incident Form](#).

12p - 1p. This Capital Cities Community College Consortium (C5) Zoom forum offers perspectives on engaging with Native American communities and students. It shares experiences at Native American-Serving Nontribal Institutions (NASNTIs). Authorized under Title III of the Higher Education Act, the NASNTI program provides grants to enable institutions enrolling a minimum 10% Native American students to improve their capacity to serve Native American and low-income individuals. The presenters in this Zoom forum are from public, nontribal NASNTI postsecondary institutions with student populations that are above 30% Native American. Zoom information will be forthcoming.
