**5911 Campus Emergency Radio Line:** Call 5911 if you observe/witness/experience - water leaks or flooding, power loss, lighting issues, icy sidewalks, fallen trees or limbs, office or classroom lockouts, tripping or slip hazards, out of the ordinary noises in the attic or walls, broken windows, animals on campus. 5911 can also be used to request a 'safe walk' to your

**Overnight Parking:** Overnight parking is allowed on the Weed campus only. It will be available for Lodge residents and students or employees participating in overnight college sponsored trips. A valid overnight parking permit must be displayed, hanging visibly from the rearview mirror of your vehicle. Permits can be obtained as follows: Lodge residents will receive theirs in their welcome packets, athletes from their coaches, and Upward Bound/TRIO participants from their leads. Each permit comes with a corresponding map outlining authorized overnight parking areas. Parking overnight in an area not designated for overnight parking, or parking in a designated area without a visible permit may result in warning notices or citation.
