- **Maintenance, Facilities and Construction Updates:** On Tuesday, we will have Cal Safety and Diversified Electric on site working on re-pulling the fire wires between the ground box near the athletic training center and the student center boiler room. Please watch for workers in the parking lot areas. On Thursday, we are having an evacuation and attendance drill in the Emergency Services Training Center Building at 2:00PM. The evacuation location is zone x, the grass area on the west side of the gymnasium. Evans Building & Excavating, Inc. are still working in parking lot A and E on sidewalk preplacement. They are also working on two unsafe conation corrections located at the west entrance of Life Science and the entrance nearest to the Board Room of the Student Center Building.
