Our Performing Arts Department is thrilled to present "She Kills Monsters." Performances are scheduled for Friday and Saturday evenings, November 3, 4, 10, 11, 17, and 18 at 7 p.m. and Sunday afternoons, November 5 and 12 at 3 p.m. in the Weed Campus Kenneth W. Ford Theater.

Identity, grief, and triumph intersect in this zany, fantastical play by Qui Nguyen. "She Kills Monsters" is a story about kids who make up stories; stories in which girls wield swords, and nerds rule the earth.

A comedic romp into the world of fantasy role-playing games, "She Kills Monsters" follows the journey of Agnes Evans as she leaves her childhood home in Ohio following the death of her teenage sister, Tilly.
