The speech should be no longer than five (5) minutes in length.

May 1 - 3, 2024	Speeches presented to review panel and final selection made. (Exact date to be determined; students will be contacted by April 30 for scheduling)
May 6, 2024	Applicants notified of decision made.
May 17, 2024	Graduation Rehearsal – 1:00 pm, Weed Campus Football Field Graduation Ceremony – 6:00 pm, Weed Campus Football Field

Selection Criteria*

The following criteria will be used to evaluate speeches:

1. Content: Does the speech have a clear thesis that is supported with interesting, meaningful examples and ideas?
2. Development of Topic: Is the subject (topic) developed to relate to graduation, COS, and/or student life while attending COS?
3. Delivery: Is the speech clear and understandable? Is there sufficient eye contact? Does the speaker talk with feeling?
4. Each candidate will be evaluated on the above criteria by each member of the review panel. The panel will use those evaluations in determining the graduation speaker.
