Nursing students who have already earned a baccalaureate or higher degree from an institution of higher learning are not required to complete any general education requirements. Instead, these students only need to complete the coursework necessary for licensing as a registered nurse.

If the District decides to use the multi-criteria screening process, the District shall submit a plan for approval to the California Community College Chancellor's Office.

Military personnel and veterans may be eligible for credit for military training and experience.

The Nursing Program will adhere to the District's compliance with Title 5 Sections 55060 et seq. and 55521 regarding availability of all services of the District to nursing students.

The Nursing Program will participate in data collection and reporting as necessary to comply with Health & Safety Code 128050, for the collection, analysis, and distribution of information on the educational and employment trends for health care occupations in the state.
