The District maintains a plan for the provision of programs and services to disabled students designed to assure that they have equality of access to District classes and programs. Student Access Services (SAS), formerly known as Disabled Student Programs and Services (DSPS), is the primary department by which the District accommodates students with disabilities. Programming within this department allows for the following services and academic offerings:

- Procedure for timely response to accommodation requests involving academic adjustments which, at a minimum, provides for an individualized review of each such request, and permits interim decisions on such requests pending final resolution by the appropriate administrator or designee;
- Long-range goals and short term measurable objectives for the program;
- Definitions of disabilities and students eligible for the program;
- Support services and instruction that is provided;
- Technology accessibility;
- Verification of disability;
- Student rights and responsibilities;
- Student academic accommodation plan that is developed by the appropriate SAS certificated staff member in consultation with the student;
- Academic accommodations, adjustments, auxiliary aids, and services;
- Provisions for course substitution and waivers;
- Staffing;
- Advisory committee;
- Assessment for Learning Disabilities Eligibility (if appropriate and available); and
- Curricular offerings in basic skills, academic strategies, assistive technology, and adaptive P.E. (if appropriate and available).
