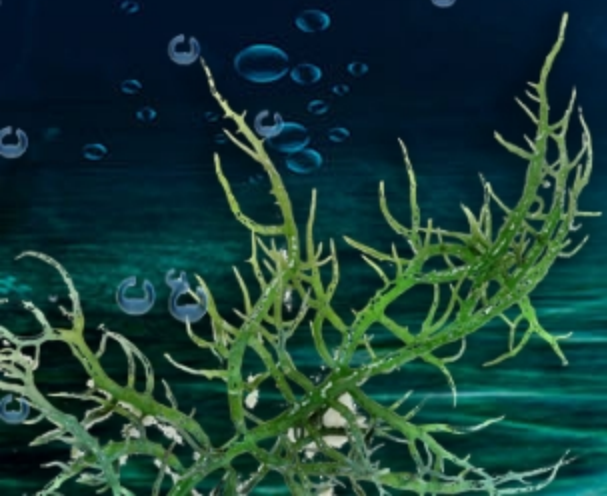

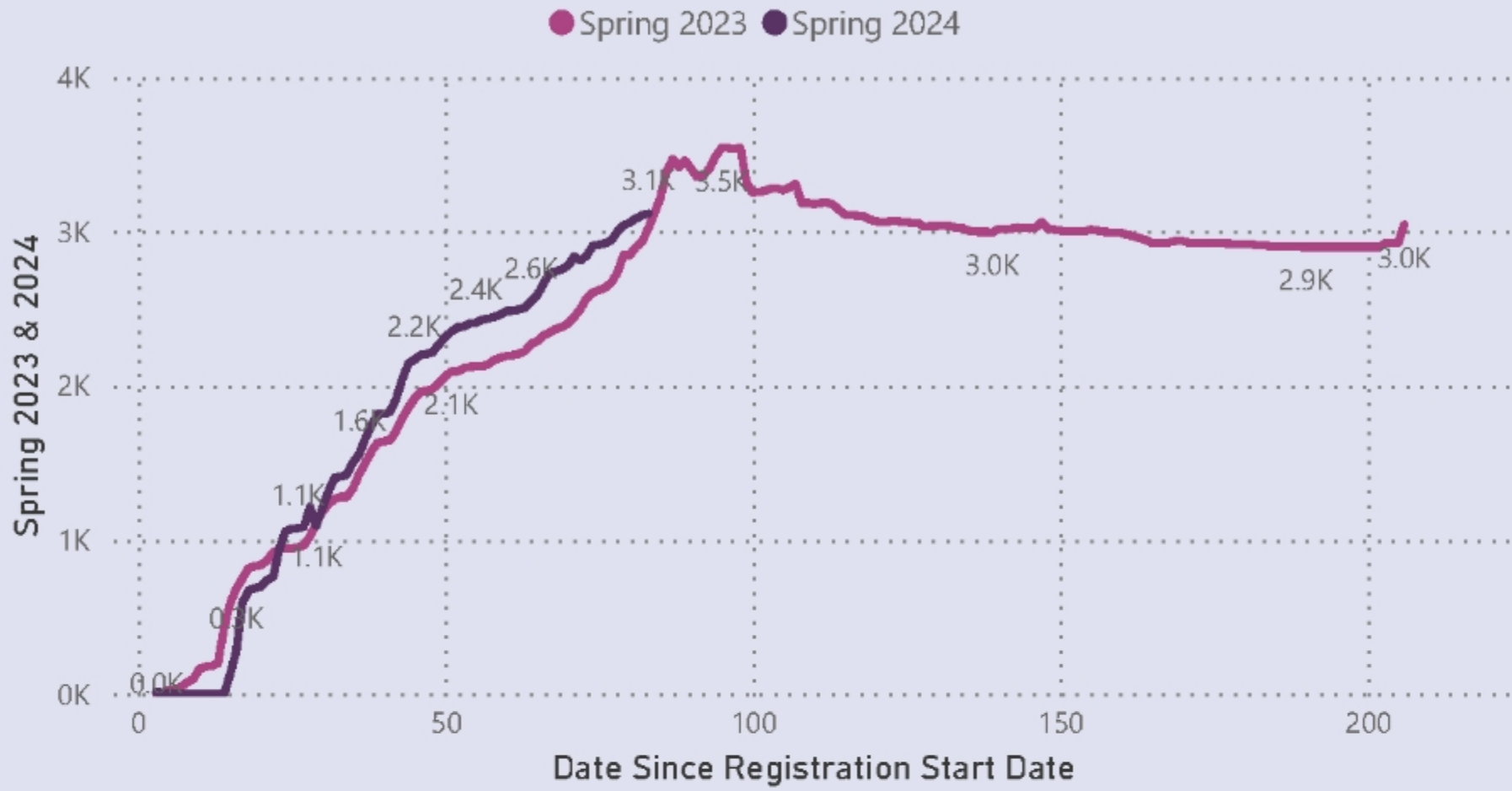

Spring 2023 & 2024 Credit Enrollment Numbers



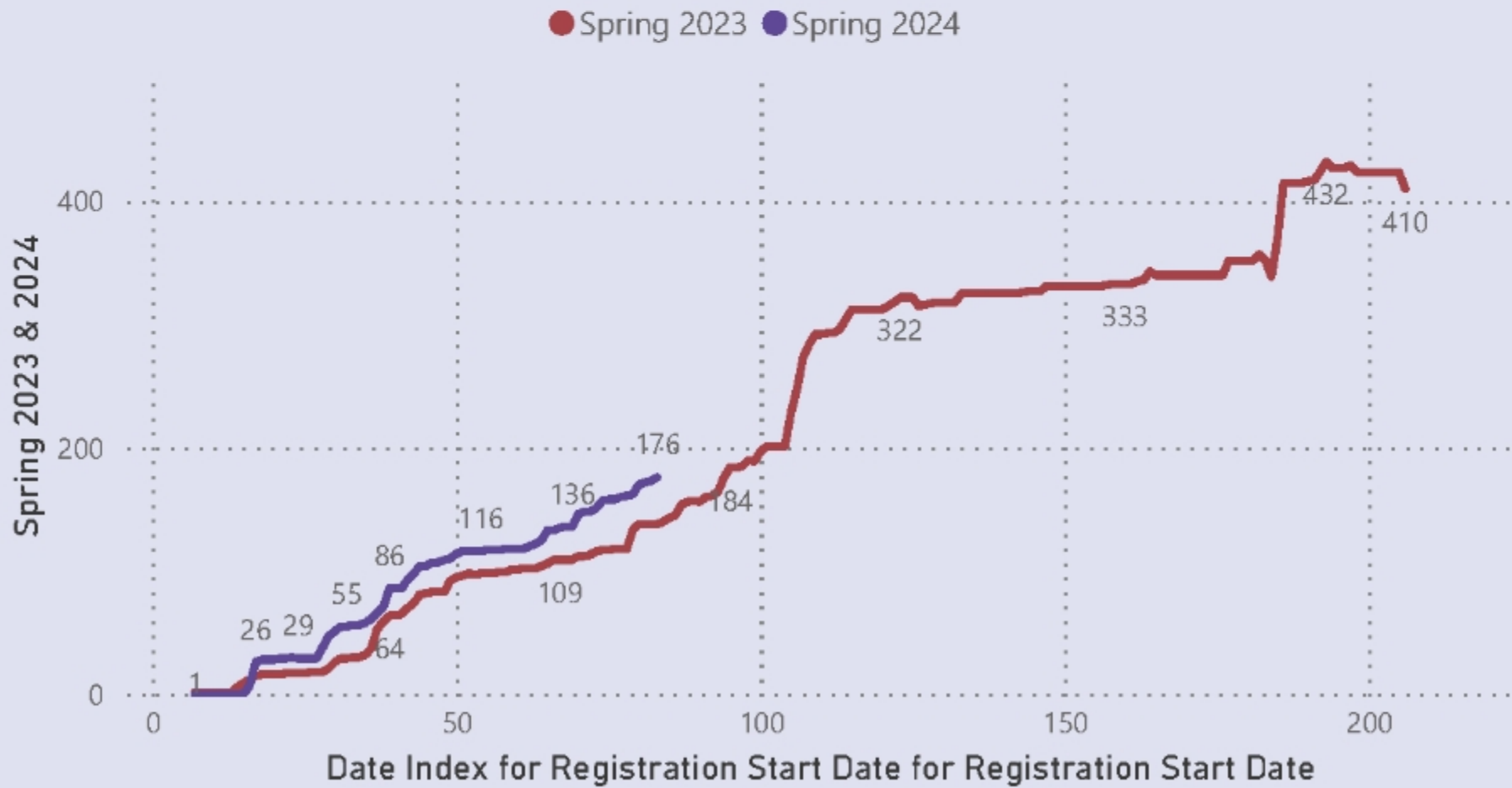

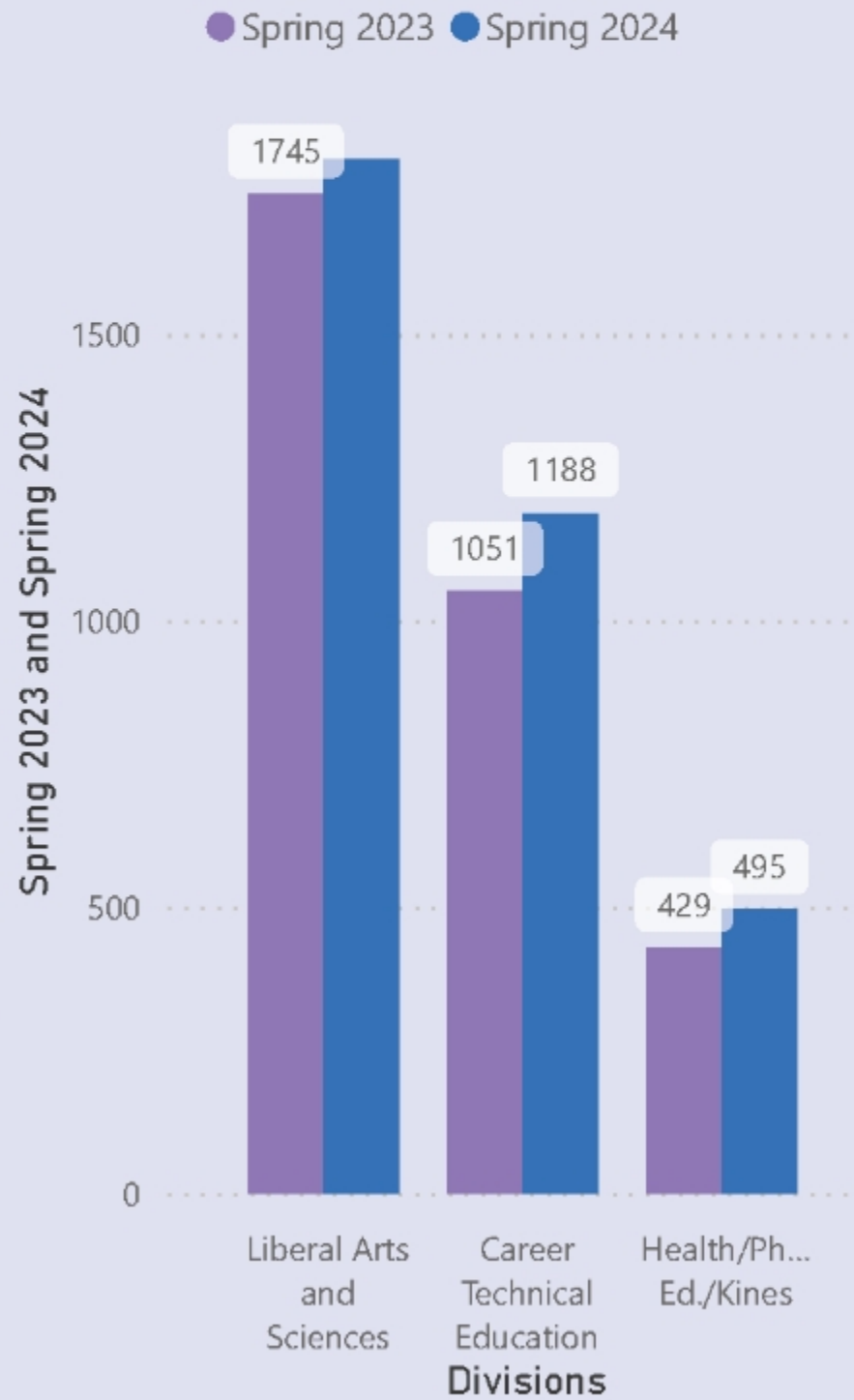

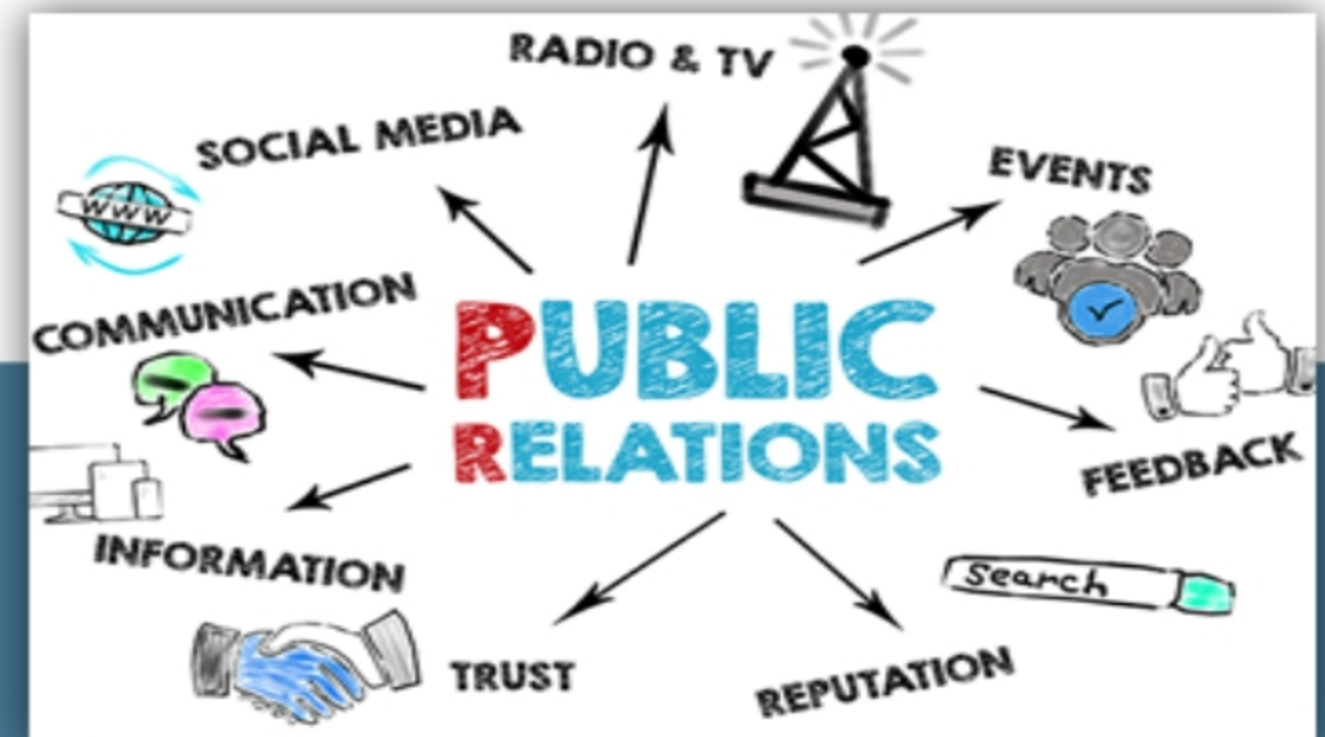
