College of the Siskiyous Student Survey / Housing Demand - Fall 2019









Executive Summary

Thank you for the opportunity to evaluate your on-campus housing demand. We have evaluated the results from our on-line student survey conducted in October 2019 and have developed several observations regarding desirability of housing on the campus of College of the Siskiyous.

Demand Exists

Servitas believes there is sufficient housing demand for a New Project from College of the Siskiyous, Weed campus students to support development of up to approximately 302 beds as of Fall of 2019.

Overall the survey found 74% of the total enrollment willing to consider living at a new residence hall, that figure rising to 85% for respondents under the age of 25:

- 85% of students currently living with "Parents, Family or Relatives" would consider living in the new residence hall.
- 76% of students currently living in a "Rental Property", would consider living in the new residence hall.

Students Would Pay More to Live On-Campus

When asked about the value of living on-campus, 37% of students responded it was worth "\$100 or more per month" than living off-campus, 15% answered "\$200 or more".

Students Prefer to Share a Room to Save Money


- 37% or respondents reported sharing a bedroom to reduce rent costs.
- A large percentage of students (54%) preferred the double occupancy floor plans.
- The Two Bedroom, Two Bathroom Suite with kitchenette proved to be the most popular unit being chosen by 21% students.
- 40% of respondents were willing to pay \$100 or more per month to have a private bedroom, with 15% reporting they were NOT willing to share at any price point. (lower than other surveys)





Floor Plan Demand

The survey results of the floor plan choices are below:



Of the five floorplans offered to respondents, the top three, which we recommend are:

- 1. Two Bedroom, One Bathroom Plan with kitchenette Single Occupancy
- 2. Two Bedroom, Two Bathroom Plan with Living Room and kitchenette Double Occupancy
- 3. Two Bedroom, One Bathroom Semi-Suite (no kitchenette) Double Occupancy

In addition to being the floor plans most desired by COS students, this program offers COS students options for all ages: for 18-24-year olds who preferred the double occupancy kitchenette plan and for students over the age of 30 who preferred the double occupancy SUITE (no kitchenette) plan, or who preferred the privacy of a single occupancy bedroom.





Details of Survey Sample

Our projected 302 beds of demand is based on willingness of surveyed students to consider living at the described project, specifically a NEW Residence Hall on campus, proposed to be located on the Weed campus.

Servitas received 368 unique responses (Survey closed on November 17, 2018) to the COS housing survey, which is a statistically valid sample yielding an overall 96.0% confidence level and a 4.77% margin of error.






Location of Students

Units and Rents

Our 24% of all respondents reported budgeting more than \$600 per month for housing costs including utilities. Servitas sees healthy demand for new housing in the following floor plans at the rents below, with the caveat that construction costs will need to be low enough to allow the project to be built at these rent levels.





Community Description

The preference of students to live on-campus while attending COS, MORE THAN DOUBLED after reading a short description of the proposed housing - 33% grew to 74%.

Respondents indicated, that despite increased costs, they would like a fully amenitized project, including, ranked by priority:

- 1. Internet Included in the Rent
- 2. Food Service / Cafe / On-Site Dining
- 3. Study Rooms
- 4. Fitness Center
- 5. Student Lounge Areas

- 6. Fully Furnished Unit
- 7. Ceiling Fans
- 8. Secure Designated Parking (For Residents Only)
- 9. Alarm System
- 10. Computer Lab in the Building

Conclusion

Based on the findings of the Fall 2019 COS Student Housing Survey, Servitas recommends a project between 280 and 300 beds, within the overall average gross demand found for new on-campus housing of 302 beds.

Furthermore, Servitas recommends the following floorplan program based on our findings. Suggested MONTHLY rent levels show below are predicted to produce demand for the beds in each floorplan.
