Information

- I. Noel Levitz Survey Presentation (Nathan Rexford)
 - Nathan Rexford attended in Bart Scott's place to present the results of the Noel Levitz Survey. One questions that came out as over the national average was: "Campus Staff are caring and helpful."
 - Nathan advised that it would be prudent to look at bridging the gap between satisfaction and importance.
 - Other positive areas were "My Academic Advisor is knowledgeable" and "[I received] personalized attention through the admissions process."
 - Some room for growth examples include "I receive feedback on progress..." and "Financial Aid awards are awarded on time to be helpful for college planning." "My Advisor helps me apply my program of study to career goals" came up as a need for improvement; however, it was stated that this is not a function of advisors at our institution.
 - Other discussion was had regarding improving Financial Aid related responses. This included the possibility of opening up Financial Aid packaging earlier. Also, there could be possible confusion on which year FAFSA to fill out because of which FAFSA year Summer falls into.
