Student health services shall be provided in order to contribute to the educational goals of students by promoting physical and emotional well being through health oriented programs and services.

The Student Health Fee paid at registration provides the following services for students:

• Free services at the Health Clinic held are available once per week on campus during regular semesters. Such as,

MEDICAL SERVICES

- Primary and preventive health care
- Basic lab services and blood draws
- STDs, Birth Control, UTI
- Physicals CHDP, Sports, DMV
- Immunizations
- Tobacco cessation

BEHAVIORAL MEDICINE SERVICES

- Counseling
- Addiction and related disorders
- Behavioral Disorders
- Tourette's syndrome
- Stress, Anxiety, Depression Treatment
- Accident insurance for class related injuries. This is a secondary policy which covers students during the time they are enrolled. The College does not assume any responsibility for student accident or injury beyond the coverage provided by the student accident insurance (AP 5205).
- Health education programs and events.
- Psychological Personal counseling by appointment.

Students may purchase health insurance separately through a College recommended plan.
