II. Website Discussion

Option #1: COS runs on a program called Bootstrap: Weblinks showed a new version of our current home page. Reduced the number of dropdowns so that it's easier to navigate. Moved Staff Resources to the top (instead of red bar). Incorporated important dates and brief descriptions. Also added bigger 'buttons' for Admissions and Records, Financial Aid, Distance Learning and Athletics. The bottom lists social media posts as well as includes student success stories.

Option #2: Showed another version which had a revised the 'slide indicator' and modified buttons.

Option #3: The third version shows a larger picture on the home page, includes a full menu and a search bar that appears in the middle when clicked. Discussion: Regina pooled Ambassadors and they all like option #3. Question ensured regarding the version of Bootstrap which is being used. Weblinks mentioned that it wouldn't be difficult to transfer over to an updated Bootstrap version.
