Meeting Notes

- Thought process behind merging Pillars 2/3 – *The benefits of merging the groups were shared by Pillar 2 and 3 co-leads:*
 - *good use of time due to shared interest in some efforts that overlap both pillars;*
 - *more folks to share the workload;*
 - *assist with pillar 3 due to dwindling attendance at their meetings;*
 - *help to keep focus and momentum;*
 - *have focus groups work on specific efforts, and use monthly larger group meetings to report out*
- Input from the group:*
 - *preference is to keep the pillar meetings separate, and meet have the co-leads from pillars 2 and 3 meet to establish the bridge between efforts, focus the meeting efforts as needed, determine where we have shared goals*
 - *use google docs to track efforts; then people can choose their areas of interest*
 - *determine desired outcomes*

We need a way to expand to non-CTE students too. College OPTIONS is making YouScience free. The use of GP funds was explored, but is not appropriate because it would not be a direct COS expense, and would have to go through Siskiyou Works to be paid.*
 - d) *Onboarding/Orientation (Charlie and Josh) – MyPath is now live. Modifications to cards and tiles can be made at any time as needed. Meghan and Val are the administrators of the program.*
