Hello Siskiyous and Happy Bastille Day!

Updates this week:

- **Updates to Safety Protocols (PLEASE READ):** Thank you to everyone who contributed feedback regarding the new OSHA safety guidelines. In consultation with constituency groups, the safety protocols have been updated as follows:
 1. Face coverings are not required for students, faculty, and staff who are fully vaccinated. By entering a building on a College of the Siskiyous campus not wearing a mask, you are self-attesting that you are fully vaccinated.
 2. Face coverings are required for those who are not fully vaccinated.
 3. Social/physical distancing requirements have been removed, with the exception of major outbreaks.
 4. Unvaccinated, or partially vaccinated, students and employees need to wear face coverings indoors and when in vehicles with more than one person.
 5. N95 masks will be available for those that would like one upon request.
 6. When necessary, employees may get tested for COVID during work hours.
 7. The HealthScan app is still required for all employees due to the College's need to track employees in reporting COVID cases. (IMT is meeting tomorrow morning to determine if it will also be required for certain cohorts of students as well as to review the questions to determine the need for updating. IMT will also be discussing the possibility of discontinuing the Kiosk but having a 'check-in' available for those without smart phones. An update will be provided in this month's Campus Connection).

Updated safety protocols are effective immediately and will be widely communicated via our website, COS Connect and social media sites. An easy-to-read flyer will be reviewed in IMT tomorrow and, once reviewed, will also be distributed widely.
