

March is designated Women's History Month by presidential proclamation. In 1978, Women's History Month started as Women's History Week by the Education Task Force of the Sonoma County Commissions on the Status of Women. In 1980, the National Women's History Aliance successfully lobbied for national recognition and, the president at that time, Jimmy Carter, issued the first Presidential Proclamation declaring the week of March 8th as National Women's History Week. It wasn't until Congress passed Public Law designating March as Women's History Month in 1987. This year's Women's History Month theme is: *Providing Healing, Promoting Hope*.
